Scholarships: It is that time of the year where seniors should start exploring scholarship opportunities. There are different types of scholarships for students. First all students and parents need to fill out the FAFSA (Free application for federal student aid). The new start date for FAFSA is Oct. 1st. The second step after you have completed your FAFSA is to research scholarship monies from the campus they will be attending. You can find campus scholarships on the individual schools web page. Just type the word scholarship or freshman scholarship in the school's search engine to see what each college/university requires. The final types of scholarships would be national scholarships, outside scholarships and local. Please check out all of these scholarships on the Catholic Central High School web site. Additionally, check with your employer to see if your son/daughter is eligible for monies. Don't forget searching for scholarships and filling out applications is a job. The more applications you apply for the higher odds you have of winning. Good Luck!
