US HISTORY TOURS GETTYSBURG – MARKS 13TH CONSECUTIVE TRIP FOR CCHS

On March 23rd through the 26th, 32 CC students and 15 parent chaperons traveled to Gettysburg, PA for the 13th consecutive US History Gettysburg field trip. This was the 9th trip directed by US History teacher Mr. Meddaugh. Students were able to experience what they learned in the classroom on the hallowed ground over two days at such major sites as McPherson's Ridge, Culp's Hill, Devil's Den, The Peach Orchard, Little Round Top, and Cemetery Ridge to name a few. Students walked Pickett's Charge, stood where the men of the Iron Brigade stood (Wisconsin soldiers), and read the Gettysburg Address approximately where Lincoln delivered the immortal speech almost 155 years ago. These students are now part of a Catholic Central tradition where close to 500 students have gone on this unique history experience furthering their understanding of an important moment in our nation's history.



The whole group poses by the Eternal Light Peace Memorial which was dedicated on the field for the 75th Anniversary in July, 1938. Over 1,800 veterans came to Gettysburg for this dedication, soldiers from both the North and the South.

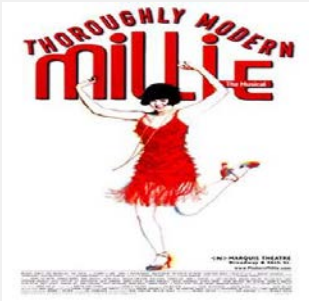

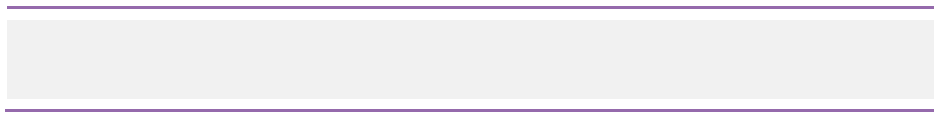

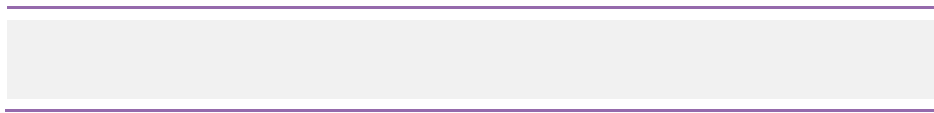

- Copies of your supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.
